



Providing specialist airfield assessment and remediation planning in post-war Iraq

The Challenge SkyLink Air and Logistics (USA) needed to establish aviation services quickly in post-war Iraq in order to provide much needed aid and relief.

The Solution PDL Toll assembled two teams at short notice to be flown to the US to receive pre-deployment training. At the completion of this training the two teams were deployed to Kuwait to wait on clearance to move into Iraq.

The Results The first team tackled the task of preparing the first commercial assessment of Baghdad International Airport and the second team tackled a similar task in Mosul. Both teams produced detailed work plans for remediation of the airfields to allow commercial operation to restart under the auspices of US AID.
