



## Integrated logistic support for the Regional Assistance Mission in the Solomon Islands

**The Challenge:** In October 2003, Australian Federal Police and Defence Force personnel joined other Pacific nations to form the Regional Assistance Mission in the Solomon Islands (RAMSI). This mission was established at the request of the Solomon Islands Government to re-establish law and order and the Commonwealth of Australia has made an ongoing commitment to help. This meant the need for a logistics partner able to provide all aspects of logistic support.

**The Solution:** PDL Toll offered a prime contractor model whereby it provides the full scope of camp support services from a single point of contact. This support includes garrison support, repair and maintenance, catering, land, air and sea transportation and full medical services. Due to the geography of the Solomon Islands, PDL Toll provides support to a number of locations throughout the Solomon Islands as well as a supply chain base in Australia.

**The Results:** Since 2003, PDL Toll has consistently provided logistic support to the RAMSI mission through a number of major changes and challenges. The camp has fluctuated in size from as high as 1800 to it's current steady state of 400 personnel. Throughout these changes, PDL Toll has offered consistent service and acted as a single point of contact and a reliable partner to the Commonwealth to enable them to concentrate on their job.
