



Camp support logistics for the Australian Defence Force in Timor Leste

The Challenge: When civil unrest broke out in Timor Leste in 2006, the Australian Defence Force (ADF) deployed 1500 personnel to assist with peacekeeping activities. This contingent needed full camp support logistics at short notice and under extremely challenging conditions.

The Solution: The ADF engaged PDL Toll as the prime contractor to provide complete logistic support. PDL Toll quickly mobilised personnel and resources to establish fully operational services within a short time frame. These included hospital and medical services with fully equipped operating theatres, kitchens and safe food preparation facilities, a supply chain for both food and fuel, and aviation support services including fly-in fly-out personnel rotation

The Results: PDL Toll has provided camp support logistics for the ADF in Timor Leste since 2006. During this time, personnel levels have fluctuated between 1200 and 1500, but what hasn't changed is PDL Toll's commitment to providing the highest possible levels of service. The key to achieving this has been having the flexibility to evolve with the changing needs of the ADF while maintaining the reliability to ensure uninterrupted support.
